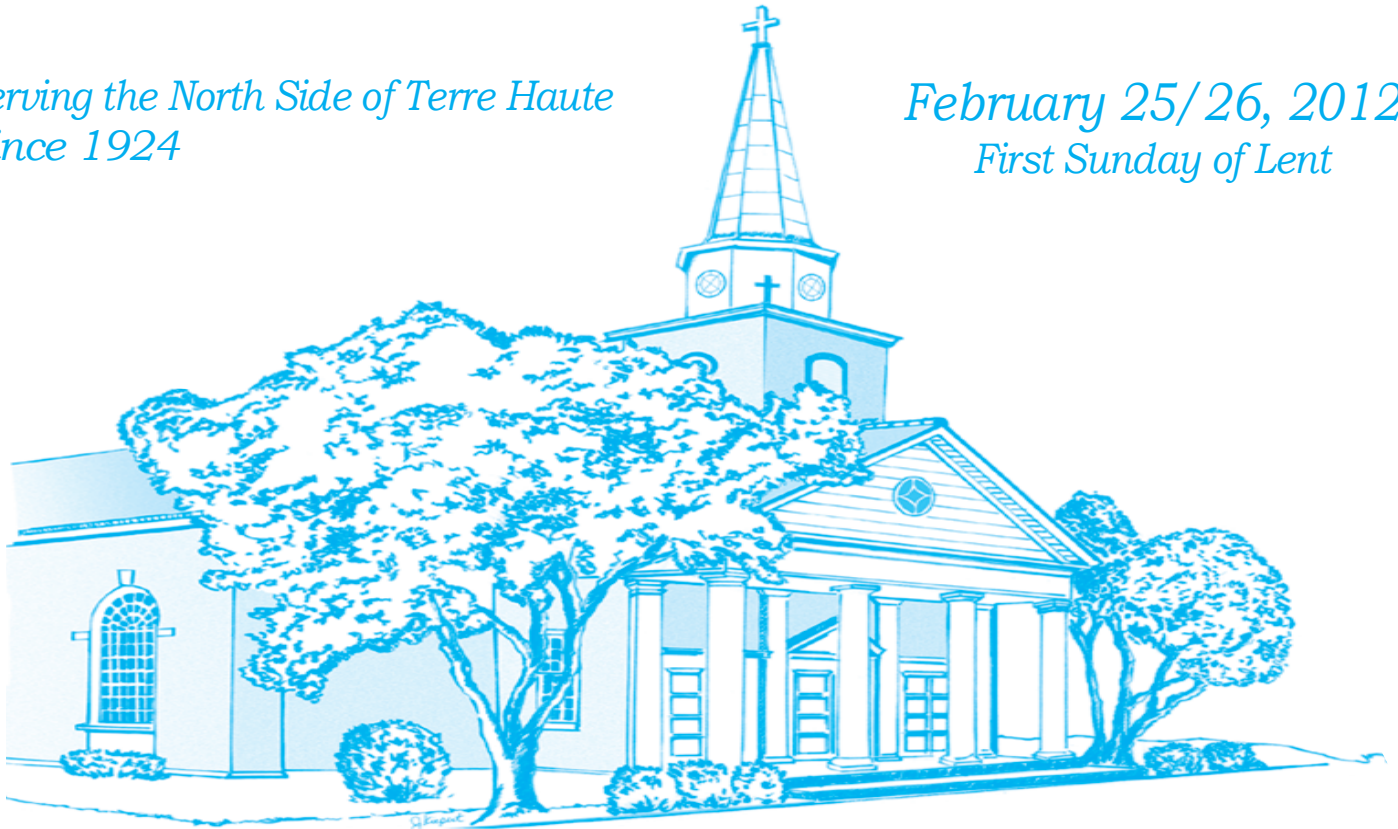

## Scripture this Week

The temptations Jesus endured in the desert are the same temptations that we face. That is, to accept the values of the world and to identify with them. In the desert Jesus is asked to “Turn these stones into bread.” In other words do something ~ then you will have value. The tempter continues, “Worship me!” Worship money ~ and I'll give you possessions. And again: “Jump from the Temple.” Do something flashy, impress people and they will speak well of you. Do these things and you will have value! Do these things and you will be loved!

But Jesus doesn't fall for it, he holds on to the affirmation of his baptism, “You are my beloved son, with whom I am well pleased.” So when the world said: do something and you'll have value ~ Jesus said: I don't have to **do** anything because I know who I am. I am the beloved and that gives me value! And when the world said: worship money and you'll have possessions. Jesus said: I don't need possessions because I am the beloved. And when the world said: do something flashy and impress us. Jesus said: I don't get my identity from you. My identity comes from God because I am his beloved.

If we can believe that the words spoken to Jesus are also spoken to us then the world can't touch us either.

Let us use this season of Lent to remember who and whose we are, and to humbly do his will.
