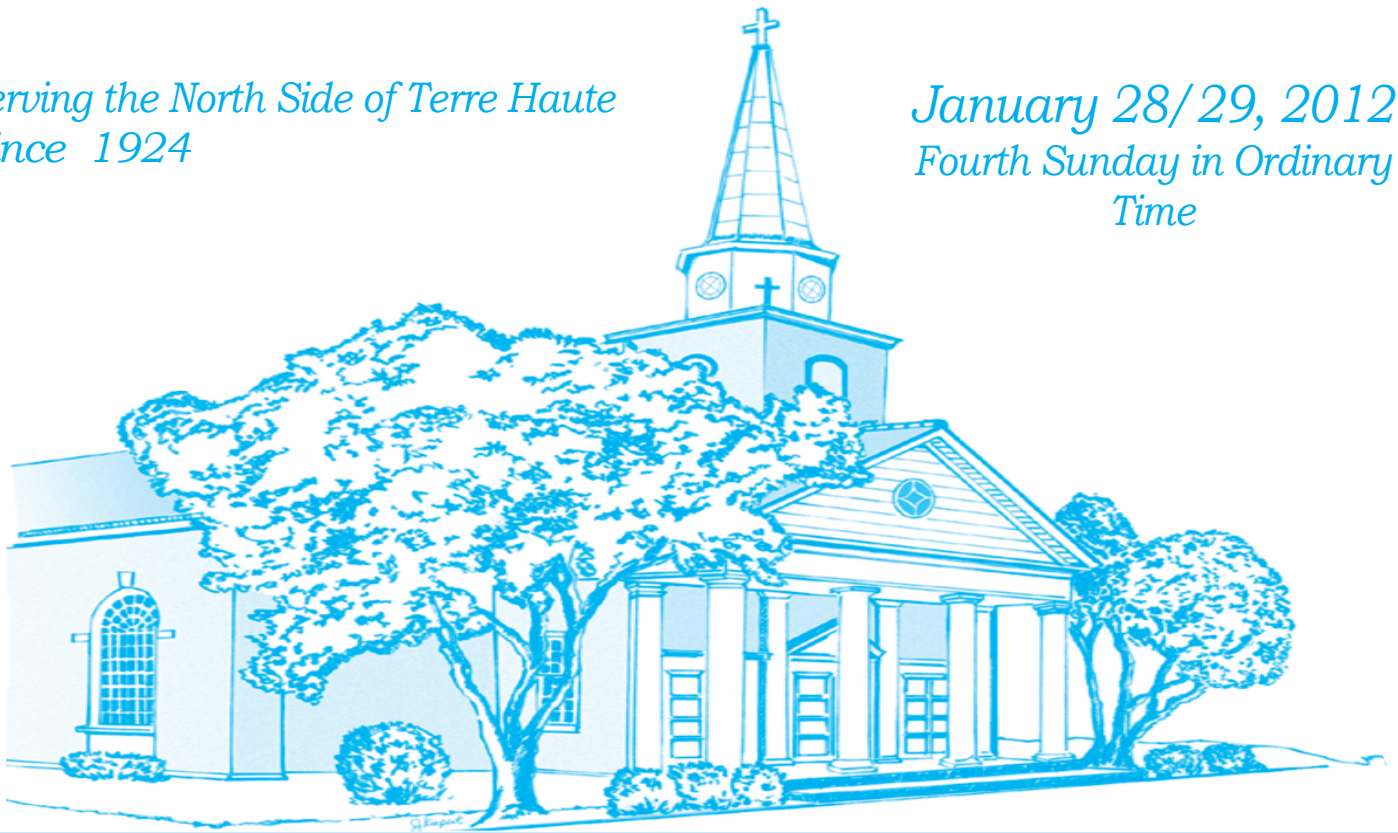

Today I am drawn by the second reading. How wonderful it must have been to be a single man or woman when Paul wrote this. Apparently, their only concern was how to please the Lord. Married people, on the other hand, are anxious about their spouses and families and don't have time for considering things of the Lord.

Compare then to today...Married people are still concerned about their spouses and families, but single people also have many anxieties. All of us are bombarded by the influences of society most of which have to do with making number 1 happy. It is really difficult for EVERYONE to take time to consider things of the Lord.

So what are we going to do about it? Individually, we may not make a big impact on society, but we can make a difference in our own lives and the lives of those close to us. It's up to us to make time for the Lord without distraction. If we don't, who will?
