## Scripture this Week

Today's readings deal with the subject of leprosy. Leprosy is "a chronic infectious disease that primarily affects the peripheral nerves, skin, upper respiratory tract, eyes, and nasal mucosa." In ancient times it was thought to be highly contagious and so those with leprosy were shunned and forced to live outside regular society. In addition, whenever they came close to others, they had to warn them by ringing a bell or announcing that they were unclean.

In the gospel we see Jesus once again defying the rules of the day. He touches the leper, thereby curing him of his affliction. How heartening it is for us to know that a simple touch can cure us of all our sins and afflictions. All we need to do is follow the example of the leper...go to Jesus. Get close enough for him to touch our hearts. And then, in faith, beg him to help us.

The upcoming season of Lent is a great time to get closer to God, but why not start early?
