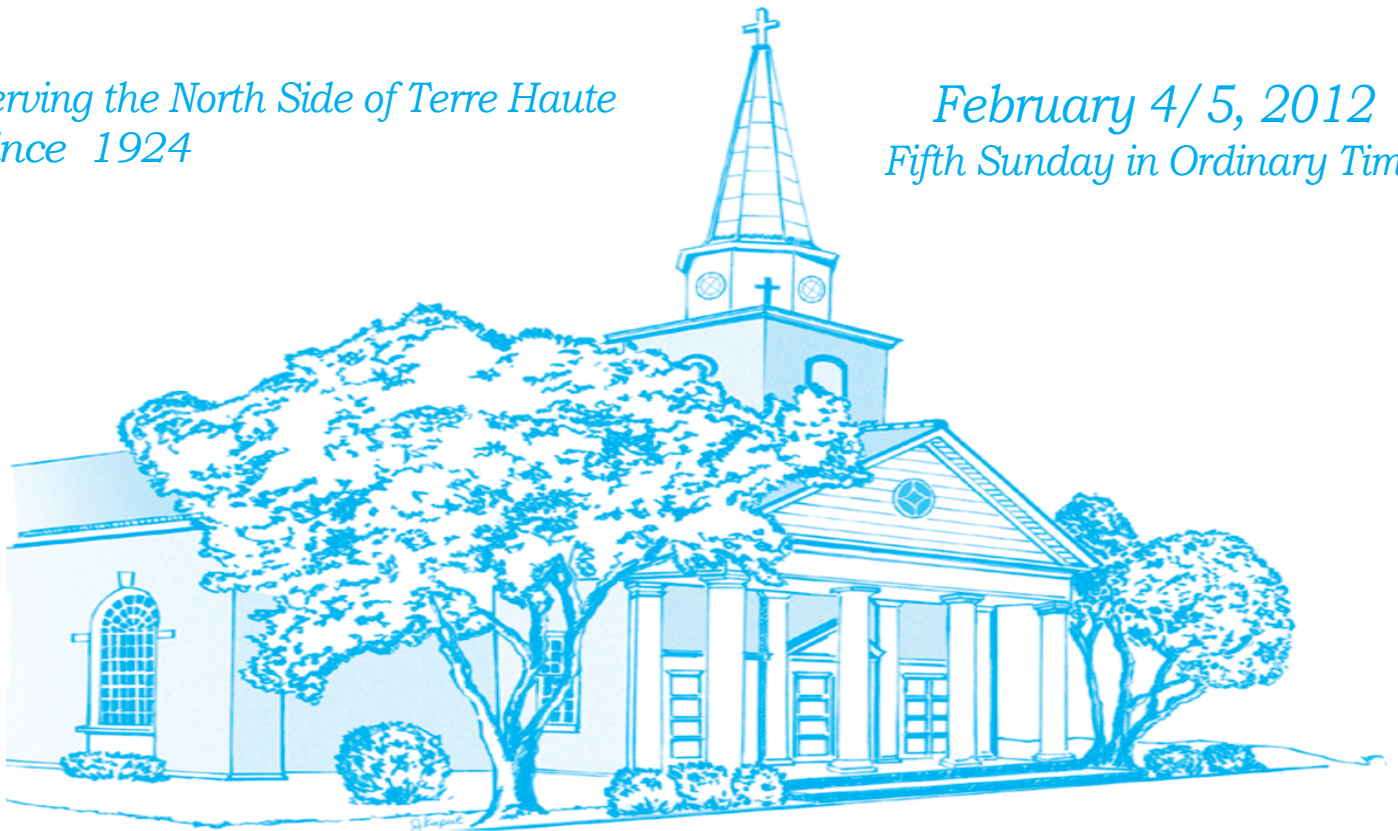

Our first reading from the book of Job is a real downer! Job goes on about how dreary and hopeless this life is. In case you're not familiar with Job, he was a wealthy man with a large family. In a series of catastrophes, he loses all his wealth and his children are killed in a house collapse. Job's "friends" insist that he must have sinned for his life to take such a downward turn. Throughout the book Job maintains his innocence as well as his faith in God.

The trials of life are many...loss of job, break up of relationships, death of loved ones. Sometimes, like Job's friends, we try to figure out what we did to deserve this tragedy. We wonder why God is testing us.

If we read the beginning of the book of Job carefully, we see that it is not God who is testing us, but Satan who is testing our faith in God. Satan is sure he can cause us to forsake or "curse" God.

As Job says in today's reading, life can be dreary, sometimes it seems that we have "been assigned months of misery." Will these challenges cause us to turn from God, or to him for his strengthening grace?

Why Do We Bless Throats on St. Blaise Day?

The feast of St. Blaise is celebrated on Feb. 3.

Many Catholics might remember Saint Blaise's feast day because of the Blessing of the Throats that took place on this day. Two candles are blessed, held slightly open, and pressed against the throat as the blessing is said. Saint Blaise's protection of those with throat troubles apparently comes from a legend that a boy was brought to him who had a fishbone stuck in his throat. The boy was about to die when Saint Blaise healed him.
