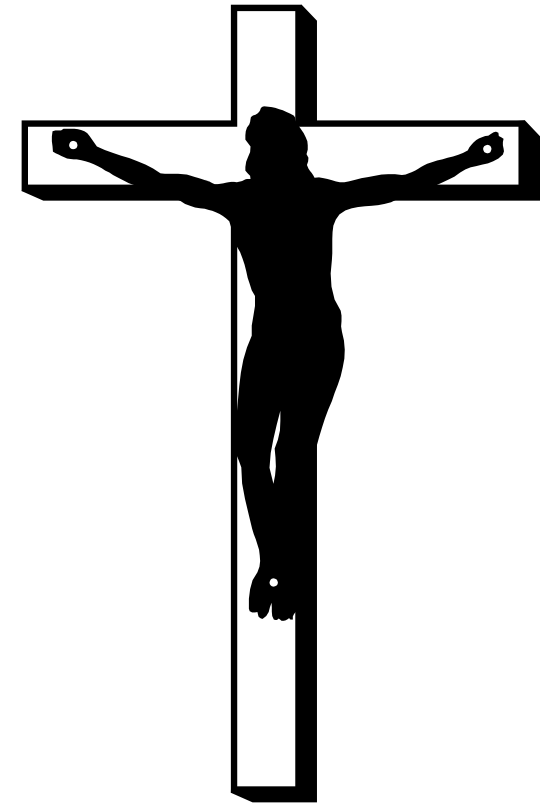

and veer R onto Clay Lick Rd. CYO is
2 miles up the road – Go over the bridge
and uphill and you’re there!

WHO'S INVITED? All youth in the Terre Haute Deanery, Grades 9-12

DRIVERS: must be 21 years old. Parents may be needed to help with transportation! Drivers for Friday should be at St. Ben's 5:45 pm. On Sunday, drivers need to arrive at CYO Camp at 10:00 am to transport youth to 10:45 Mass and lunch at St. Agnes and then back to Terre Haute.
